Because they are a herding breed, they will chase and nip at the heels of young children as well as moving objects. Prolonged confinement and neglect can produce aggression in this breed. They are a sensitive dog and do not respond well to hard handling. Positive reinforcement methods, regular training and socialization as well as a structured, loving home life are best for the Australian Shepherd"
